A. Call to Order & Roll Call

B. Sheriff

Deputy Garcia gave the Sheriff's Report for August 2016 and updated the Board on September activities. The written report is on file with the District. He reported on the eradication of marijuana groves, a stolen vehicle, and the arrest in the recent homicide incident. He also reported on the positive results of the additional CHP patrol efforts.

F. Discussion of Legal Matters

General Counsel Jackson reported on the written legal opinion received from Attorney Kelly Salt of Best, Best & Krieger regarding Proposition 218 matters. Board discussion followed. It was the consensus of the Board to finalize the contract with Richard Wilson of the marketing firm Sentium Strategic Communications and invite him to attend the next Board meeting to discuss matter further.

G. On-Going Community Outreach Program

Director Rami presented a proposal of a future rate structure. The Board took no action on this item.

H. Finance Committee Report

Director Adams reported that at their recent meeting, the Finance Committee reviewed the District claims; the progress of the annual audit and collection of benefit fees from Department of Fish and Game, and funding of the additional CHP services.

I. <u>Engineering Committee Report</u>

Director Bianchi reported that at the recent meeting, the Engineering Committee discussed the 2016 Crack and Slurry Seal project; the change order for additional striping services that was added to the contract; additional CHP services; and cost comparisons for the PMS system. He also stated there were no new tract and parcel maps received. Director Buescher was absent from the meeting.

J. General Manager's Report

General Manager Holmes presented his written report which is on file with the District Office. He updated the Board on citations issued by the CHP, and the progress future gas tax legislation.
