D. S.C. GAS CO. AMI POLE INSTALLATIONS:

Mr. Dennis Lorde, Advanced Meter Public Affairs Manager for Southern California Gas Co, made a presentation to the committee regarding AMI pole installation in the De Luz CSD. Mr. Lorde's presentation included information about the PUC's approval to provide AMI services to Gas Company customers, details of the services provided and proposed location of poles necessary to remotely read their customer's meters. The Committee asked Mr. Lorde to have the Gas Company contact the Santa Margarita HOA and all homeowners near the proposed pole installations to inform them of the proposed pole installations and provide feedback to the DLCSD Board of Directors. Mr. Lorde indicated that he believed the Gas Company could make the notifications prior to next week's board meeting. GM Holmes stated that he would place the matter on the Agenda for the board meeting pending the Gas Company's ability to make the requested public notifications.
