MINUTES REGULAR MEETING OF THE ENGINEERING COMMITTEE Wednesday, September 14, 2016 1:30 p.m.

A. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Committee Member Bianchi was present.

B. PUBLIC COMMENT:

None

C. MINUTES:

Minutes of the August 10th, 2016 meeting were approved.

D. FIELD SERVICES REPORT:

Maintenance Supervisor Keith Caddy updated the Committee regarding field crew's current activities and upcoming priorities. Caddy noted that currently the field crew's completed roadway prep for the crack and slurry project and began spraying of weeds along edge of pavement and tree trimming.

E. TRAFFIC CALMING ON SANDIA CREEK DRIVE:

GM Holmes reported that he has started to receive the daily reports from the CHP patrols of Sandia Creek Drive. Majority of citations issued have been for stop sign violation and speeding. Director Bianchi stated that he would like to see the District consider expanding the CHP patrols to more roadways.

GM Holmes reported that he has contacted Lew Gluesing of Willdan Engineering regarding another limited scope traffic study for Sandia Creek Drive at El Prado Road. During the discussion, Mr. Gluesing noted that essentially the same situation is present at this location as exists at Avenida Del Diablo and Sandia Creek except there appears to be better sight distance and the traffic has an alternative access to a four way stop. The results of the previous study did not support the placement of a stop sign. GM Holmes recommended that the District not do an additional traffic study for this location at this time.

F. PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE SYSTEM:

General Manager Holmes has not received Riverside County's PMS proposal. Holmes reported that he would review and place that date on the PMS cost comparison spreadsheet when available.

G. TRACT AND PARCEL MAPS:

GM Holmes reported that no new tract or parcel maps were received this month.

H. DISTRICT PROJECTS:


GM Holmes reported that the District project "2016 Crack and Slurry Seal" has started and is anticipated to be completed near the end of September. GM Holmes noted that a project change order has been issued to add the striping of numerous District roadways with a focus on "Stop" legends and stop bars. This work takes advantage of favorable contract striping costs.
