F. STORM DRAIN IDENTIFICATION PLAN

Engineer Hunt gave an update on the design work for Sandia Creek and Via Vaquero which are both FEMA projects and reviewed the plans with the Committee. Final design remains to be completed as well as CEQA matters that need to be resolved. Cost estimates were discussed as well as the estimated life of the installations being designed.

G. SMALL RECONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Engineer Hunt reviewed the first phase of reconstruction projects resulting from the 2019 storms and which have been submitted to FEMA. This involves the first 25 smaller storm damage project in areas throughout the District. He reviewed the draft plans and cost estimates with the Committee.
