A. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Committee Members Debbie Roberts and Raymond Johnson were present. The meeting was held electronically via Zoom.

Also present were: General Manager Emmons; District Project Engineer Stein; District Traffic Engineer Libring; and Administrative Assistant Richards

B. PUBLIC COMMENT:

There was no public comment.

C. MINUTES:

Minutes of the September 14, 2021 meeting were approved.

D. ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

SANDIA CREEK/ VIA VAQUERO (FEMA)

Project Engineer Stein indicated that the environmental permits had been approved, and that Murrieta Development (the contractor) is awaiting the delivery of pipes for the project. He anticipates that the project will begin on October 25, 2021. The contract has sixty (60) working days to be fulfilled after the project begins. Stein also stated that the yearly slurry project will include the Sandia Creek Road detour route repair project. However, as previously noted at the last meeting, Buenos Camos Road requires immediate attention and will be repaired as part of routine maintenance.

BUENA VISTA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

District Engineer Hunt reported that everything is progressing as expected. All of the environmental permits have been submitted and final review of permits is still being processed. There are no further details at this time.

E. TRAFFIC ISSUES

Traffic Engineer Libring reported that the County of Riverside placed chip seal on De Luz Road and will include rpms to the entire street when completed. The CMS sign is being rotated each week to different streets to encourage drivers to exercise caution and watch their speeds.

F. FIELD CREW REPORT


Traffic Engineer Libring reported that staff is continuing to collaborate with homeowners to maintain good sight visibility and reducing encroachments. Also working with CHP and contractors to help remove the debris that has been dumped throughout the district. No further updates at this time.

G. PERMITS, SUBDIVISION MAPS AND COUNTY ISSUES:

General Manager Emmons reported that the District has had positive actions regarding the Municipal Service Review for De Luz CSD. It was noted in the report that the CSD is requesting Fuel Tax funds for maintenance of roadways. LAFCO agreed to propose to the Board of Supervisors that the original resolutions be changed to qualify the DLCSD miles of highway for Fuel Tax..
