A. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Committee Members Raymond Johnson and Debbie Roberts were present. The meeting was held electronically by Zoom.

Also present were: General Manager Emmons; District Engineer Hunt; District Traffic Engineer Libring; and Administrative Assistant Richards.

There were no members of the public present.

B. PUBLIC COMMENT:

C. MINUTES:

D. SANDIA CREEK AND VIA VAQUERO RECONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Engineer Hunt reported that there have not been any new developments regarding the final review of the environmental permits. He will have more updates next meeting in April.

E. BUENA VISTA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Engineer Hunt resumed discussion regarding the three (3) options for 2021/2022 Capital Improvement project. He presented to the committee with the current status of the damage on Buena Vista Road. The committee reviewed each option with Mr. Hunt. After discussion, the committee will be recommending to the Board Buena Vista Road as the 2021/2022 Capital Improvement project. Committee will be continuing meeting on Monday, March 15, 2021 at 5:00pm, for the purpose of finalizing the presentation to the Board.

F. TRAFFIC ISSUES

Traffic Engineer Libring reported that the CMS sign is being rotated each week to different streets to encourage drivers to exercise caution and watch their speeds. He reported that County of Riverside installed a new guardrail along Rancho California Road. He also advised that a red curb was added on Camino Gatillo Road to prevent vandalism of existing traffic signs.

G. FIELD CREW REPORT


Traffic Engineer Libring reported that staff will be rechecking 223 drains for any weeds, silt or other accumulations. He provided an update on the status of building a public works application that will keep track of all field work and maintain accurate records.

H. PERMITS, SUBDIVISION MAPS AND COUNTY ISSUES:


